Flashpoint South China Sea. Here, China and the US are fighting for supremacy in the Indo-Pacific. In the tussle between the superpowers, the Philippines finds itself caught in the middle. What's the backstory? For decades, the People's Republic has been consolidating its military presence in the maritime region, occupying atolls and reefs to establish military outposts – on Philippine territory in particular. But there is resistance to this expansion policy: Philippine President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. is turning away from the China-friendly policies of his predecessor and cozying up to western partners – first and foremost the US... much to Beijing's chagrin.
